It increases your benefit amount 8 percent per year up to age 70 if you wait past your full retirement age to begin collecting (and were born in 1943 or later).

If you first become eligible for Social Security retirement benefits in 2020 through attaining age 62, becoming disabled, or dying before age 62 your PIA (full retirement age benefit) will be the sum of (a) 90 percent of the first \$960 of your average indexed monthly earnings, plus (b) 32 percent of your average indexed monthly earnings over \$960 and through \$5,785, plus (c) 15 percent of your average indexed monthly earnings over \$5,785
